Wichita Falls / Childress PIQ Meeting – Held in Wichita Falls

Monty Brown, DOC WF, presented information. Safety Share was presented by WF:
Discussed Work Zone Awareness Month.

Discussed general notes from WF, which included:

- No more than 10% RAP in surface mix. It used to have no RAP in the surface mix. Utilize RAP percentage as specified in all other layers. Childress only allows 10% RAP in all mixes. No RAS is permitted in any mix. No RAP allowed in PFC.

There was a discussion on RAP percentage and how we can increase it. Travis Patton MTD discussed the ongoing research on allowable binder and the guidance document on RAP stockpile testing. WF and Childress are interested in increasing their RAP percentage but are concerned with seal coat aggregate in the RAP stockpile.

There was a discussion of the ride quality workshop that Glen D presented last year. WF has emphasized the importance of putting tools in the toolbox to achieve better ride scores. Currently, WF has an average of 50 IRI on their projects completed over the last two years.

There was a discussion on using FPS 23 and Tx ME for their designs. WF currently uses SMA & SP as surface mixes, and Childress uses SP C as surface mixes.

Discussed the use of SAC A & SAC B aggregates and the availability of aggregates. At this time, most aggregates used in both districts are SAC A (the only aggregate available)

MTD discussed activity reports from Binder, Aggregates, and Flex Pave and noted that we will have a MASTERS program on June 25 to discuss activities.

Corey S presented resources and gave an activity report that TXAPA is working on. Also gave an update on APPIP and where we stand.
